

Level 2 Award in Electric/Hybrid Vehicle Routine Maintenance Activities

COURSE AIM

1) This Award is designed for technicians who maintain and repair hybrid EV technology vehicles, but not the hybrid system itself. It contains the knowledge required to work safely around a vehicle's hybrid system, whilst carrying out repairs or maintenance.

Therefore, on completing this 'single unit' qualification, technicians will have gained both knowledge of high voltage hybrid EV technologies and an understanding of their dangers.
