A high quality performance product providing a high standard of cleaning, degreasing and disinfection. Designed for a wide variety of applications, e.g. the cleaning of floors, walls and equipment etc. and also for cleaning the interiors of food delivery vehicles where a high standard of cleaning and disinfection is required.

Product Features

- A highly effective hard surface cleaner, ideal for use where food is processed.
- May be used neat on ovens to remove baked-on carbon deposits and fats, or diluted and used in floor scrubbers where it's residual antistatic properties protect from risk of static shock.
- Highly effective through all forms of foaming equipment and produces a very rich clinging foam.
- Complies with the European Suspension Test (BSEN1276) when diluted 1:50 (2%) after a contact time of 30 seconds and has been found to be effective against the following bacteria: Listeria monocytogenes, MRSA, salmonella typhimurium, pseudomonas aeruginosa, Escherichia coli, staphylococcus aureus and enterococcus Hirae.
- It has also been tested under BSEN1276 and found to kill 99.9% of germs within 30 seconds when diluted 2%
- It also has passed the BS5929 (1984) Triangle Taint Test at 2% dilution and showing it to be non-tainting to foodstuffs and safe for use in a food-processing environment without the need to rinse i.e. food safe.

Directions for Use

Note: Use biocides safely. Always read the label and product information before use.

- Wash floors and walls using a clean mop or cloth, then rinse with clean water and allow to dry.
 Rinse out mop or cloth.
- May be diluted up to 200 times when used through a high-pressure washer, even in hard water areas.
- When used at up to 1 to 50 it is also an effective bactericide.

Reloading 2L Bottle Pack:

- 1. Open 2L cabinet
- 2. Carefully remove empty bottle from the 2L cabinet by unscrewing the cap
- 3. Insert opened new 2L bottle into cabinet, insert the dispenser dip tube into the bottle
- 4. Screw cap securely onto the bottle and position bottle in cabinet securely
- 5. Close and lock cabinet
- 6. Prime system into a suitable vessel

Shelf Life

It is recommended that this product is used within 12 months of purchase in the UK climate and within 6 months in warmer climates. Do not allow to freeze.

Environmental Hazards

- Neat product will cause damage to plant and animal life.
- Do not allow large quantities of neat liquid to enter surface waterways as serious ecological damage may be caused.
